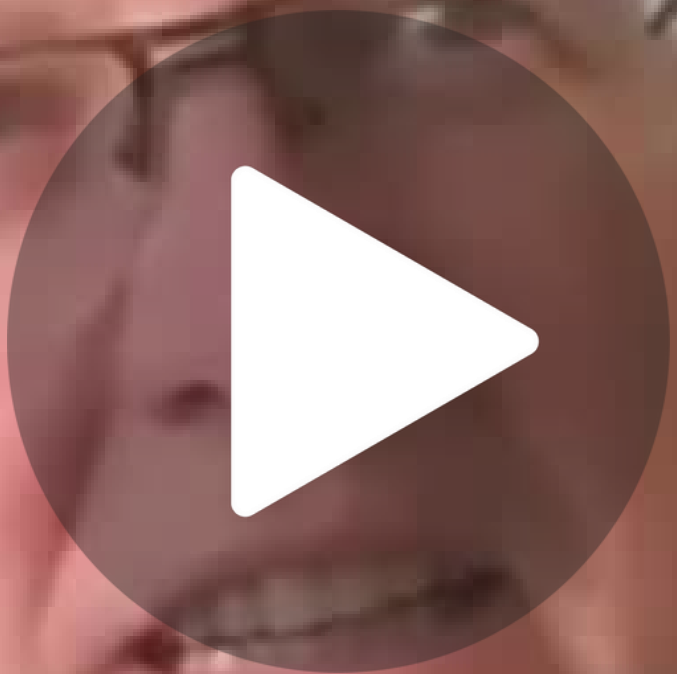


WHAT IS THE COMMUNITY PRACTITIONERS NETWORK?

Guest Lectures

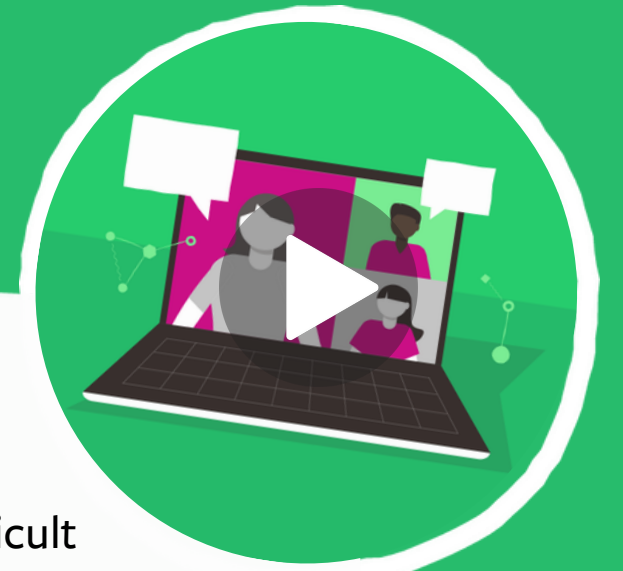
Guest speakers from across the globe share their insights and knowledge on a range of subjects from developing global citizen assemblies to the theories behind social movements.

Webinars

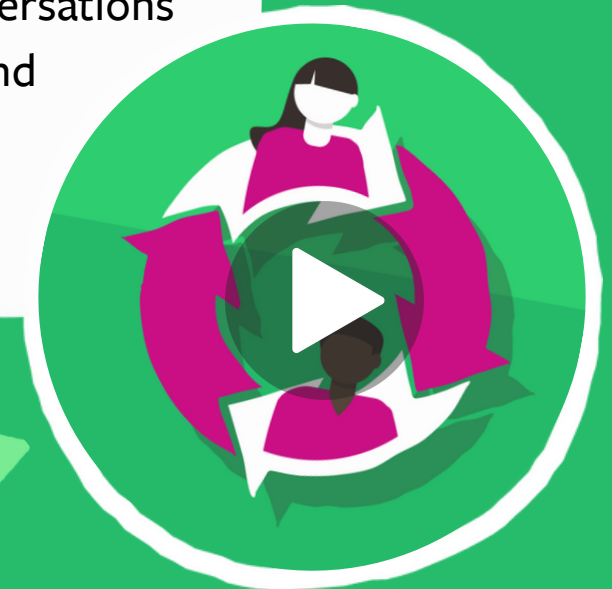
Providing practical advice on working with communities including sessions on how to build effective digital campaigns, hosting difficult conversations and funding models for community organising
